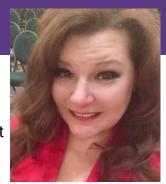

For those who love music, we host two performances in the dining room each month. If it is social time you are looking for, we host happy hours every friday- with one "special" happy hour each month.

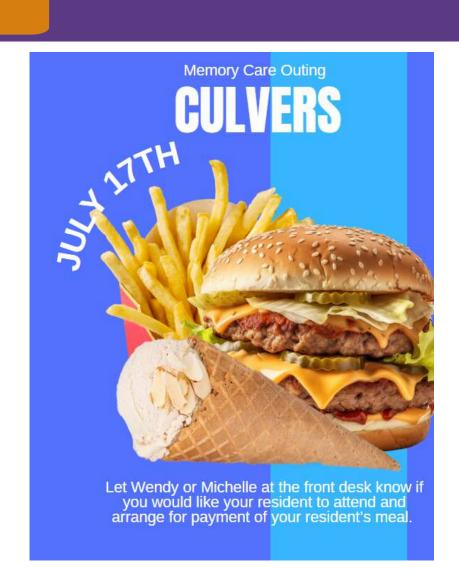
Our socials, happy hours, and Tuesday barbecues provide not just delicious treats, but opportunities for residents to laugh, mingle, and make lasting memories.

## **Fun Facts About July**

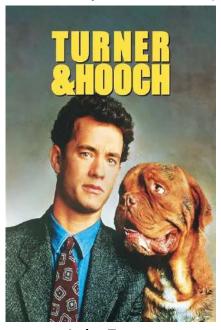
- \* July is named after Roman dictator Julius Caesar (100 B.C.–44 B.C.). Caesar developed the precursor to the Gregorian calendar we use today.
