
Community Life with Wendy

From the Desk of the Chaplain


September 1st is Labor Day which is the honors of all who work which includes all of you who are retired. You all have worked hard your entire lives, and this is your season to rest.

Pendant vs Front Desk

Do you need to get a hold of someone but don't know who to talk to? Check this chart out to see who you should talk to.

Pendant Press your pendant when any of

these may apply: Chest Pain

- Shortness of Breath
- Dizziness (feeling unable to safely transfer)
- Fall (unable to get up)
- Fire or major water leak
- Injury or bleeding
- Any other type of medical or health emergency
- Need to use bathroom prior to scheduled toileting service
- Escorts (outside of resident's service plan)

Overuse of emergency pendant can lower response time in a true emergency. Residents may also incur additional charges related to use of emergency pendant.

Front Desk

Call the front desk when you have questions or problems with any of these things:

- · Water, heat, windows
- Menu or kitchen questions
- Want to talk to nurse or HHA
- Activity information
- eMenu (family help)
- Appointments
- Mail and packages
- · Grocery orders
- Housekeeping (spills)
- · Billing information
- Needing to reschedule care conference
- Need medication list printed for doctor appointment




